



Maura Moynihan is a Senior Fellow at RPA and leads Friends of Moynihan Station. A life-long New Yorker, Ms. Moynihan is a best selling fiction writer and a distinguished journalist. She worked on all four of the Senate campaigns of her father, Daniel Patrick Moynihan, and was a research consultant for the Museum of the City of New York's acclaimed 2004 exhibition, "New York's Moynihan," which documented the life of the late Senator. She attended high school in India when her father served as the U.S. Ambassador and worked for many years on the Indian subcontinent as a refugee advocate and social worker. Ms. Moynihan speaks Hindi, Urdu, Tibetan and Nepali and created the Radio Free Asia Kathmandu bureau in 1999. Her best selling short story collection "Yoga Hotel" was published in 2003 by ReganBooks. Ms. Moynihan is presently completing a novel and writing a memoir about her father, also for ReganBooks.
